PROJECT LIGHT EMERGENCY SAFE HOME

Raleigh Dream Center is partnering with the Safe House Project, which works to unite communities by offering training, resources and referring clients to long-term care options across the nation. The biggest need is for EMERGENCY SHELTERS for victims to begin their care before moving on to a long-term care facility. There are not enough beds available here in North Carolina for the amount of women exiting out of a sex trafficking situation.

Our Emergency Safe Home will be designed to assess and address the most common variables that cause survivors to relapse and achieve stabilization through holistic therapy addressing mind, body, and spirit.

The home will provide beds for survivors for around 30-45 days. The program provides each survivor with acute trauma care, medical evaluations, mental health and wellness assessments, legal advocacy, case management, and long-term residential placement in partnership with Safe House Project and The Wellhouse, a gold-standard facility in Alabama.



Partner With Us To Reach & Restore

PHASE 1: 2024

- \$200,000
- Open emergency safe home (includes start up costs, rental property, and staffing for 1 year).

PHASE 2: 2025

- \$800,000
- Purchase property & ministry space, tripling the number of beds available for emergency home.

PHASE 3: 2026

- \$500,000
- Open long-term facility at Raleigh Dream Center alongside the emergency home.

ADOPT-A-BED

- Adopting a bed at \$500 a month provides women with more than just a safe place to sleep, but a place to begin healing and all their basic needs. To recognize the opportunity for life change, a personalized plaque is placed on the bed to encourage each survivor that there are people supporting them.

PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION

- Give a gift of \$40,000 to purchase a van specifically for the many transportation needs for the home.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

After volunteers pass a background check, sign a compliance agreement and go through our training program, there are many critical areas for volunteers to support:

- **Intake Team** – Includes delivering in-kind donations from RDC's warehouse, purchasing needed items for new rescues and keeping all intake essentials stocked.
- **Administrative Team** – Includes regular administrative duties as assigned by the Project Light staff.
- **Facility Team** – Includes facilities and grounds maintenance as well as handyman work around the property.
- **House Sitter Team** – An ongoing weekly need that includes house sitting during designated hours for safety and accountability.
- **Transportation Team** – An ongoing need for volunteers to use their own vehicles to transport residents to and from appointments.
- **Teaching Team** – Meeting weekly for a determined period of time, this team includes teaching residents approved Bible studies and life skills classes.
- **Trauma Care Team** – A daily need, the coaches assist with mentoring and coaching (additional training required).
