MISSION To bring hope and restoration through the message of the Gospel for those who have been hurt and broken by difficult circumstances.

Raleigh Dream Center is a Christian-based, volunteer-driven organization providing social services and community programs to homeless, abused and impoverished high risk youth, individuals and families. We partner with local churches to provide resources to under-privileged communities and reach out to those involved in substance abuse, physical abuse, experiencing homelessness, participating in gangs, or other circumstances that can be harmful to both an individual and to society. Everything RDC provides is intended to build relationships and trust that will lead to Gospel conversations and to help people to **DREAM AGAIN** about what God has planned for their future.

VISION To be an inner city resource center focused on finding Christ-centered solutions to homelessness, hunger, trauma, addictions, and lack of education through residential and community outreach programs.

With poverty, drug addictions and crime statistics continually on the rise, our facility will focus on the full successful transformation of people's lives that only comes through the power of God. Raleigh Dream Center is a safe environment to provide supportive services and resources free of charge to help people experience the fullness they can find only in Christ.

OUR MINISTRIES

ADOPT-A-BLOCK: This is an opportunity to serve at a local community (apartment complex or mobile home park) to build transformational relationships. Volunteers meet at 10am in different communities every 2nd & 4th Saturdays of the month. Provides free groceries, playing with kids, prayer and more.

MOBILE FOOD PANTRY: This is a weekday opportunity that provides free groceries in local communities. Sign up to serve weekdays at a time and location that works for you.

FOOD WAREHOUSE: Every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 2-5pm we are looking for volunteers to help package up the groceries that are sent out to local communities. This allows 100,000 meals to be sent out every month across Wake County.

FAMILY NIGHT - STREET OUTREACH: Every Tuesday we go to Moore Square to minister to people experiencing homelessness and invite them back to RDC for a free dinner and worship service. Sign up to serve at Moore Square or at the Family Night dinner and service.

KIDZJAM: Specifically for the children, KidzJam volunteers bring games, crafts and a bible lesson to hundreds of children through our Adopt-A-Block outreach, after-school KidzJams, and at Family Night.

DREAM CENTER DISCIPLESHIP PROGRAM: This is our free residential recovery program for men and women to overcome addiction.

SUMMER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM: Our 9-week paid internship for students 16-24 that develops ministry leaders through biblical study, training, and serving each day in our summer kids camps directly in communities.

LOCAL MISSIONS OPPORTUNITIES: We have year-round options for families and groups to serve in missions. This includes summer serve weeks, church "serve" events, summer internships for students, and more. Contact us to see how your family, church, or business can be involved.
